Eligibility Requirements for Design Professionals

- * Provide proof of professional licensure in the field of engineering, architecture, landscape architecture, forestry, geology, land surveying or CPESC.

Eligibility Requirements for Plan Reviewers

- * Have at least 6 months work experience in the field of erosion and sediment control.
- * In lieu of 6 months work experience, an individual may obtain a Level 1B certification

Requirements for Level II Introduction to Design

"Certified Design Professional" "Certified Plan Reviewer"

- * You must register for and attend a Conservation Commission approved and posted "Introduction to Design Seminar" (Level II).
- * Submit the appropriate application* (Note: Application will be distributed before the exam.)
- * Take and receive a passing score of 70% on a Level II certification exam.
- * A **photo ID** is required to sit for the exam.
